The Pre-Bid Meeting was started with the recitation of few versus from the Holy Quran.

- **O2.** The pre-bid meeting was convened and chaired by the Project Director (PD), Project Management Unit (PMU), Emergency Flood Assistance Project (EFAP), Works and Services Department (W&SD), Government of Sindh (GoS), in the Conference Hall of PMU Office on 27 September 2023. Following staff attended:
- (1) Project Director, PMU, EFAP, W&SD GoS
- (2) Deputy Project Director, PMU, EFAP, W&SD, GoS
- (3) Assistant Director (Procurement), PMU, EFAP, W&SD, GoS
- (4) Other PMU Staffs
- **03.** In opening remarks, the Project Director, PMU-EFAP, W&SD, GoS welcomed all the participants (list attached as **Annexure-A**) for sparing their precious time and attended the pre-bid meeting. Thereafter, the Project Director explained in detail, the salient features of the Project, its aims, objectives, major components of the Project, its implementation schedule and overall utility of the services to the general public to be provided through this project. After that, Project Director, directed Deputy Project Director to explain the Bidding Documents in detail.
- Deputy Project Director with the assistance of Procurement Specialist ADB explained the bidding documents particularly the contents of Section-1 (Instructions to Bidders), Section-2 (Bid Data Sheet), Section-3 (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria), Section-4 (Bidding Forms), Section-6 (Employer's Requirements) and Section-8 (Particular Conditions of the Contract). The meeting was held in two parts. During the first part, Deputy Project Director explained in detail by reading through the important clauses on preparation of bids and application of qualification criteria. Moreover, the Section-4 of the bidding documents were explained to the bidders covering the standard format of different forms and the bidders were stressed to use the standard format of forms while submitting the bids. Further, Section-6 of the bidding documents were explained and clarified the Employer's Requirement to the bidders.
- **05.** During the second part of the meeting, participants were encouraged to ask any questions they had. Bidders were instructed to send their queries in writing to the Project Management Unit (PMU) for written responses and guidance. All the bidders indicated that after a detailed presentation of the

bidding documents, they had no remaining questions. However, all bidders collectively raised two inquiries: (i) an extension of the bid submission deadline, and (ii) an increase in the Mobilization Advance from 10% to 15%.

06. The meeting was concluded with a vote of thanks to and from all the participants. The queries received in PMU and corresponding replies thereto are attached as **Annexure-B**.
