Objective and Scope:

The Government of Sindh has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Sindh Provincial Road Improvement Project. Part of the loan will be used for the preparation of the Sindh Road Network Master Plan (2017-2036) ("the Plan") and Institutional Strengthening of Works and Services Department. The Works and Services Department (WSD) of Sindh will be implementing agency for the Project, and a Project Management Unit (PMU) has been established headed by a Project Director (Client's representative). Total road network under Works and Services department is around 53,000 Kilo Meter (Km), which needs to be covered in Road Master Plan.

A consulting firm consisting of international and national experts will be recruited on Quality and Cost Based selection Method with Full Technical Proposal in accordance with Asian Development Bank's Guidelines to help the government to prepare Sindh Road Network Master Plan and Institutional strengthening of Works and Services Department for the period of Twenty Four (24) months.

The firms should have demonstrated experience in relevant sectors and scope of work involved. The firm(s) should include following information and documents indicated in ADB's standard expression of interest (EOI) template in ADB (CMS).

The EOI must be submitted online via the ADB's Consultant Management System (CMS). The EOI must be submitted using the online template in CMS not later than **15 October 2017**.
